### **Assignment #2: Research Paper**

**Prompt:** Please compose a 1,000-1,500 word MLA source-based argument that responds to one of the following research questions:

- Should the American government provide tuition-free undergraduate college education for all American citizens?
- Should the American government legally require companies to provide paid vacation for the full-time workforce?
- Should the American government provide universal healthcare for its citizens?
- Should the American government eliminate all penalties for drug use?
- Should the American prison system be revised to mirror the Norway model of incarcerating and rehabilitating convicted criminals?
- Should the American educational system follow the French model for school lunches?
- Should the American educational system follow Finland's educational system?
- Should the American government eliminate charter schools throughout the states?
- How might America change if women gained more power in government, business, and education?
- Is Donald Trump enacting a fascist ideology in America?
- Does America exploit its workers?
- Which social systems/institutions need to be repaired/strengthened to improve America's culture?
- Which "isms" pose the most significant threats to American democracy?
- Which current political forms of resistance are most important to sustain American democracy?

**Source Materials:** Please incorporate at least four sources into your argument. One source must be *Where to Invade Next*. Another two sources must come from a library database. You choose the remaining sources. You will likely need more than four sources to make a well-informed argument, so I encourage you to enact rigorous research processes.

**Rhetorical Purpose:** Persuade

**Rhetorical Mode:** Argumentation

**Genre:** MLA Research Paper

**Audience:** Your primary audience is people who do not agree with your opinion/position.

**Focus:** Answer one of the questions provided in the prompt. Your argument can focus on one specific question or a combination of two or more questions.

**Thesis:** Your thesis statement must communicate the paper's central claim and use a topic, position, and support model (TPS). The thesis statement should be the last sentence in the introduction.

**Counter-argument/Rebuttal:** Please provide at least one counter-argument and rebuttal.

**Product:** This assignment should be 1,000 – 1,500 words. To format the text, please 12-point font and double-spacing. Please include an original title. We will use these criteria to evaluate your project:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Your argument is directed to a clear audience.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Your argument cites at least four source materials—with the film serving as your primary source.

- \_\_\_\_ Your argument uses MLA style to format the paper and cite source materials.
- \_\_\_\_ Your argument has a clear purpose: persuade.
- \_\_\_\_ Your argument provides a clear TPS thesis statement.
- \_\_\_\_ Your argument provides at least one counterargument and rebuttal.
- \_\_\_\_ Your argument shows signs of careful proofreading with minimal grammatical, spelling errors.
